Architects Host Friday the 13th Miami City Cemetery Ghost Walk Led by Historian Dr. Paul George

Miami architects will mark Friday, November 13th, this year with a Miami City Cemetery Ghost Walk led by historian Dr. Paul George. The special tour is open to the public who purchase tickets in advance.

Tickets for the tour, Dr. George's most popular and always fully-booked, are available through the American Institute of Architects Miami Chapter, 305-448-7488 or www.aiamiami.com.

The ghost walk is part of AIA Miami's Celebrate Architecture + Design, a month-long series of 34 events, including tours, exhibits, receptions, panel discussions of issues, competitions, parties and the November 21 AIA Miami Design Awards Gala.

The twilight tour will begin at 4:30 p.m. at the cemetery entrance, 1800 Northeast Second Avenue, Miami. Advance reservations are required. Tickets are \$30, \$20 for AIA members, students and tours of 10 or more. A maximum of 30 people can participate in the tour.

The architects and participants will get into the Friday the 13th spirit with Dr. George's renowned haunted history tour. Participants will lurk among the tombstones of the historic graveyard to hear his stories about the mysterious deaths of the inhabitants. They will visit the final resting places of early settlers, including Miami's first mayor, the Burdine family and Julia Tuttle. Dr. George will also point out some of the noteworthy Art Deco architecture in the neighborhood -- before it gets dark.

Flashlights and comfortable shoes are required.
